Introductory session lasts approximately 2 hours

The counselling course is completed over 22 weeks and consists of weekly 4-hour training sessions. Topics covered include:

Counselling Theory from 3 differing perspectives – Psychodynamic, Person-Centred and Cognitive Behaviour Theory; Counselling Skills; The Natures of Self; Self-Growth and Development; Ethical Practice; The Core Conditions; Anti-Discriminatory Practice; Interpersonal/Social Skills; Exploring Personal Growth and Development

A good standard of English is required to access the course content.
