Parking in Tysoe Avenue & the Home Zone
 We have, once again, seen an increase in dangerous driving on the roads around the school by members of our community. Parents and carers dropping off and collecting children from school have been reported to me and to the Police for dangerous and, in some cases illegal, driving.
 Please be aware of the following:

- Parking/stopping on a roundabout is illegal.
- Parking where there are double yellow lines is illegal.
- The Home Zone is privately owned land and parking there could lead to cars being clamped.
- Resident parking bays for the flats/properties on Tysoe Avenue should not be used or blocked by parents.

The dangerous/selfish behaviour of a few people is causing serious issues for local residents and is putting our children's safety at risk. **Please consider your behaviour, park safely away from the school and walk your child onto the site.**
